


Operator Safety, Not Cost, is the Primary Concern

By most measurements, the latest results of California workers' compensation insurers aren't too different from the results of states across the country: the cost of each case is getting higher. While the Workers Compensation Research Institute determined the average claim in Illinois was \$26,138, the average cost of a lost-work claim will be about \$65,000 according to the Workers' Compensation Insurance Rating Bureau of California.

Now, more than ever, controlling exposures to occupational hazards is the fundamental method of protecting workers and reducing costs. Traditionally, a hierarchy of controls has been used as a means of determining how to implement feasible and effective controls.
